As the Calvary Life Center construction gets underway, Executive Pastor Scott Vail will share weekly project updates and let us know what's happening out on the construction site. **Here's the latest news:**

- **The project construction trailer** arrived on Tuesday!
- **Site Works**, under the direction of Edifice, continues to clear areas designated for erosion control basins and filters and install water lines. This will take several weeks.
- **Park Shuttle: Since parking lot D** is now partially fenced due to construction, **a new shuttle will be available** to provide assistance from more distant parking areas on Sunday mornings. Signs mark drop-off/pick-up locations. An adequate number of parking spaces will remain available throughout the construction project, **so please do not park on the medians, lawn, or in fire lanes.
