## The word of truth...

At Calvary Church we believe that the Bible is the inspired and inerrant Word of God. It is God's absolute truth. Therefore the primary task of the preacher is not to give his own ideas, tell inspiring stories, be funny,

or show his creative uniqueness, but rather "to preach the Word" (2 Timothy 4:2). Paul writes to Timothy, "Do your best to present yourself to God as one approved, a workman who has no need to be ashamed, rightly handling the word of truth" (2 Timothy 2:15).

In preaching consecutively through a book of the Bible such as Daniel, inevitably we come to some passages which are more difficult to understand (and to preach) than others. Yet, because of our commitment to the Bible as the Word of God, it is important that we try to understand these passages rather than having a diet of entertaining stories loosely based on the preacher's favorite passages!

Today and next Sunday we deal with a difficult but very important section of Scripture—Daniel 9:20-27. One of the great privileges of preaching at Calvary is that people come hungry for the living Word of God. That is why I ask you to bring your Bibles! We do not "live by bread alone, but by every word that comes from the mouth of God" (Matthew 4:4). ■
