Calvary budget year ends well

“Thanks to God’s blessings and the faithfulness of the Calvary congregation, we are pleased to report that the church finished the fiscal year on June 30 with General Fund giving almost \$100,000 more than our budgeted goal. The total for this year was almost 10% more than was received in the fiscal year ending June 2009. In addition, while we are still closing the books for the current period, it is clear our expenses were comfortably less than our income,” reports John Mandeville, Calvary’s Director of Ministry Support and Treasurer.

With this in mind, the Session has adopted a budget for the fiscal 2010–11 year which anticipates General Fund giving to rise by almost 5%. Thus, the General Fund weekly goal posted in Looking Up under “For the record” (on page 2) has been changed to \$127,000. A more complete financial report will be presented at the congregational meeting on Sunday, August 15. To God be the glory!

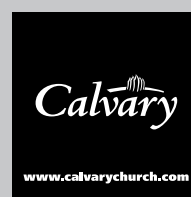
