From the Senior Pastor

Preaching on Daniel...



Dr. John H. Munro

I have been living with Daniel for the past 12 months! We commenced the series on Sunday, September 13, 2009, but I began my studies a year ago. I think I will have preached about 30 messages on Daniel (including the messages on the Rapture and on Israel). I know we have looked at some difficult passages, but your enthusiastic response has been encouraging! I praise God for the Body of Christ at Calvary which has a commitment to biblical exposition.

Next Sunday morning we will conclude the study with a review of Daniel. Over the past months we've sung some great hymns, choruses, and praise songs on the themes of Daniel. We will crystallize some of the outstanding truths we have learned and link them with some of these hymns and songs. It will be a morning of praise. I know some of you will be rejoicing that we finally finished the book! My prayer is that many of us will take a stand for God in this culture, just as Daniel did in the Babylonian culture. ■
