With a gift of 100 acres on Highway 51, Calvary puilds a 5000+ seat worship center. Ground is broken in 1986, and the new church building is dedicated in December of 1989. The new campus offers more capacity for worship and outreach, including CHAMP Sports. Powerful worship and preaching make a significant regional impact. By God's grace and provision, the mortgage is paid in full in 2008.
