Facts / Rules

- We will leave on Monday, June 26, at 1:15 PM. Check-in will start at 12:30 PM. Please eat lunch before arriving to check-in.
- We will arrive back at Calvary on Friday, June 30, around noon. We will not stop for lunch on the way back but will have snacks.
- Daily showers are mandatory.
- Small groups will be separated by gender and age.
- Cell phones are a major distraction and should be left at home. If a phone is seen, it will be taken and given back to the student on Friday.
- A contact list will be provided at check-in if you need to get in touch with your student during the week.
- Students should bring a Bible, pen, and journal.
- An updated packing list will be emailed closer to camp time.

Food

- A daily menu will be provided closer to the time of the camp.
- We will try our best to accommodate food allergies. Students with allergies are welcome to bring food.
- Students may bring snacks for the week.

Bunk Rooms

- There will be 23 students in each bunkroom with adults.
- The four rooms will be separated by gender and divided by Middle School and High School. Light sleepers should bring earplugs.

Medications

- All medications should be turned in at check-in in a zip-lock bag with clear instructions, times, and dosage. One of our adults will give the students the medicine they need at the appropriate time.

- Students will not receive mail during the week. However, you may send a letter(s) with your student for them to read throughout the week.
